Woman Sentenced to 25 Years for Selling Cocaine

Bryan, TX – Nicole Anderson, 39, of Bryan was sentenced to 25 years in prison today.

Anderson was arrested on August 29, 2013 for Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance. Officers were responding to a call about a couple selling cocaine from their hotel room.

When officers arrived, they found more than 11 grams of crack cocaine, drug paraphernalia, and more than \$1000 in cash inside the hotel room.

Anderson was arrested and transported to

the Brazos County jail. After arriving at the jail, officers discovered additional crack cocaine in the patrol car where Anderson had been riding. A subsequent search of Anderson yielded more crack cocaine that she had hidden in her underwear. In total, officers recovered 24 grams of crack cocaine.

As part of the plea agreement, Anderson was also sentenced to 10 years in prison for Tampering with Evidence.

Anderson has been previously convicted of Burglary of a Building, Prostitu-

tion, Delivery of a Controlled Substance, Possession of a Controlled Substance, and Theft.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Philip McLemore.
