Local Dentist Convicted of Felony for Hidden Video

Bryan, TX – Dr. William Birdwell pled guilty today, July 17, 2014, to improper visual recording, State Jail Felony. On May 21, 2014, the defendant who is a local dentist, secretly recorded one of his female employees as she undressed in a private restroom at his dental office. The employee saw the camera and immediately left the office and then reported the situation to the police. The police then went to the office and located the camera which had the video showing the defendant setting up the camera and then

the images of the employee. The defendant eventually confessed to the police.

The plea agreement required that Dr. Birdwell admit his guilt, and accept a felony conviction. Along with the felony conviction he will have to serve 21 days in the Brazos County Jail, as well as do community service and undergo a psychological evaluation. Any violation of his probation could result in a prison sentence of up to two years in State Jail.
