## Bryan Man Sentenced to 5 Years for DWI and Theft

Bryan, TX – James Hunn, 40, of Bryan was sentenced to 5 years in prison today for violating the terms of his 2012 probation.

Hunn was on probation for DWI when, in August of 2012, he stole two four wheelers and a weed eater from land belonging to a neighbor.

After stealing the property, Hunn and a co-Defendant sold the four wheelers. Brazos County Sheriff's Deputies were able to recover one of the four wheelers but the other was never found. Hunn also pawned the

weed eater at a shop in Bryan where deputies later recovered it.

Prior to a hearing in which prosecutors were seeking to revoke Hunn's probation, Hunn agreed to a 5 year sentence.

In addition to admitting he violated his probation, Hunn also pled guilty to felony Theft for stealing his neighbor's property. and was sentenced to 12 months in a State Jail facility.

Hunn has previously been convicted for DWI, criminal mischief, and driving with an invalid driver's license.
